Specifically, if you are applying for an education scholarship, please elaborate on why you want a career in education OR how a teacher made a difference in your life and how that experience has shaped your decision to go into education. If applying for a political science, government or public service scholarship, outline who in the current or historical political arena (city, state, or nation) would you most like to emulate and why, OR if you were a candidate for public office today, what would be your platform, OR if you were providing a public service today, what would be your motivation for providing that service?

Please Note:

- <u>The Board will consider only applications of students interested in careers in</u> <u>education, government, and public service.</u> Medical, Nursing, or Aviation applications will not be considered,
- 2. Transcripts for student applicants must be included or sent directly from the school. A minimum of "C" average for the previous school year is required.
- 3. <u>No more than three (3) additional pages should be included with your application, excluding transcripts, letters of recommendation, and essay.</u>
- 4. Photographs may be included with application but are not required.
- 5. Only Alaska residents are eligible for these awards.
